SUMMIT CNC PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

Summit Industry Partners, LLC d/b/a Summit CNC ("Summit CNC" or "We") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website https://summitcnc.com (our "Site") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- On our Site.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and our Site.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means; or
- Any third party.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Site. By accessing or using our Site, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see *Changes to Our Privacy Policy*). Your continued use of the Site after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

Children Under the Age of 16

Our Site is not intended for children under 16 years of age, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16. If you are under 16, do not use or provide any information on this Site or through any of its features, including your name, address, telephone number, or email address. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 16 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Site, including information:

- By which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, email address, and telephone number ("personal information");
- That is about you but individually does not identify you; and/or
- About your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Site, and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our business partners.

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our Site may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Site. This includes information provided at the time of requesting a sample part, signing up for the monthly newsletter, downloading e-books, requesting design, consulting, 3D printing, and/or computer numerical control (CNC) machining services, submitting a design, drawing, model or prototype to us through the Site, purchasing any services or parts, or using any "contact us" feature available on the Site. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our Site.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including names, email addresses, physical addresses, and phone numbers), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Site.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Site, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Site, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Site.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically may include personal information or we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. Data that we collect automatically helps us to improve our Site and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Recognize you when you return to our Site.

The technologies we use for automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Site.
- Web Beacons. Pages of the Site may contain small electronic files known as web beacons
 (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit Summit CNC, for
 example, to count users who have visited those pages and for other related website
 statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying
 system and server integrity).

How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Site and its contents to you.
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Site or any products or services we offer or provide though it.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

We may also use your information to contact you about services that may be of interest to you. If you do not want us to use your information in this way, please contact us. For more information, see *Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information*.

Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction.

We may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this privacy policy:

- To our affiliates.
- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business.

- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Summit CNC's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Summit CNC about our Site users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our <u>Terms of Use and Service</u> and any other agreements you enter into with Summit CNC, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Summit CNC, our employees, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- Tracking Technologies and Advertising. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this site may then be inaccessible or not function properly.
- Promotional Offers from Summit CNC. If you do not wish to have your contact information used by Summit CNC to promote our own or third parties' products or services, you can opt-out by sending us an email stating your request to service@summitcnc.com. If we have sent you a promotional email, you may send us a return email asking to be omitted from future email distributions. This opt out does not apply to information provided by Summit CNC as a result of service inquiries or requests, contracted services or other transactions.

Accessing and Correcting Your Information

You may also send us an email at service@summitcnc.com to request access to, correct or delete any personal information that you have provided to us. We may not accommodate a request to change or delete information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal

requirement, cause the information to be incorrect, or if such information is needed to fulfill your requested services.

Data Security

We have implemented measures designed to secure your personal information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure.

The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of our Site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of your personal information transmitted to our Site. Any transmission of personal information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the Site.
